Project Scope:

LAN's services were retained by the Harrison Housing Authority to design landscaping, brick paver walkways, retaining walls, site lighting, gazebo, and restoration of the limestone building panel and dedication plaque.

The sidewalks were widened with the installation of brick pavers next to new raised planter beds. Landscaping and irrigation was added at 50% of the site.

The bronze plaque was refurbished and new silhouettes were added to the building to represent the community and factory workers of Harrison.

The gazebo is a bus stop for residents which provides shelter from the weather. A heater was also provided to warm residents in cold weather as they wait for the bus.
